You have submitted an application to the Erasmus+ Programme – Jean Monnet "Modules, Chairs and Centres of Excellence" and "Policy Debate with the academic world", 2016 call for proposals for the action specified above. The call for proposals closed on 25/02/2016. The Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) received 1011 applications for these actions.

I am writing to inform you about the selection decision taken by the Head of Department of the Agency, acting in her capacity as authorising officer, based on the recommendations of an Evaluation Committee assisted by external experts.

I am pleased to inform you that your application has been selected for EU co-funding.

¹ In view to increase the participation in Jean Monnet activities Higher Education Institutions from countries outside the European Union, additional funds from the EU Partnership Instrument (PI) have been made available.

It received 87/100 points, which is on or above the minimum threshold for funding of 76/100 points given the FPI budget, available for your country.

For your information, out of the 1011 applications submitted for these actions, 68 have been selected for funding with the FPI funds. (A further 194 applications have been selected for funding with the Erasmus+ Jean Monnet Activities funds).

The list of all selected projects will be published on the website of the Executive Agency when all applicants have been notified about the selection results (http://eacea.ec.europa.eu/erasmus-plus/selection-results_en).

Attached to this letter you will find an evaluation report based on the opinion of the external experts. Please take into account that most of the evaluation reports were written by non-native speakers. The Executive Agency will not elaborate further on these assessments.

The maximum amount of funding to be awarded to your project is € 57448.

This letter does not represent a financial or legal commitment of the Executive Agency. The offer of an award is confirmed only when the legal representative of the Executive Agency signs the Grant Agreement / Grant Decision associated with this application.
